DLaxV Regelwerk für Kleinfeld (Seniorinnen)

Die hier aufgeführten Regeln sind Änderungen oder Ergänzungen des im DLaxV gültigen FIL (World Lacrosse) Regelwerks für Damenlacrosse und gelten ausschließlich für die Spiele auf Kleinfeld im Spielbetrieb des DLaxV.

Bis auf die Regeln gelten ausnahmslos die WL Regeln für Damenlacrosse, sowie die in der Bundesspielordnung des DLaxV (BSO) festgeschriebenen nachstehenden Abweichungen.

General Changes for the entire Rulebook:

- „**10m**“ replaces „11m“
- „**14m Fan**“ replaces „15m“
- „**Center Line**“ replaces „Restraining Line“

Rule 1 Field Markings: (diagram see page 4)

A. Change 1st Sentence:

... **55m – 65m** long between end lines and **45m – 55m** wide between sidelines. ...

C. Change 2nd Sentence:

The Goal Lines shall be no less than **43m** and no greater than **53m** apart. ...

D. Change:

There **must be 6m** of playing space behind each Goal Line...

The **6m** of playing space behind the Goal Line shall be measured...

1. Two small visible marks shall be added to the field behind the each goal, 4m from the boundary and **10m** from the centre of the Goal Line.

F. Change:

No Restraining Line shall be marked.

G. Change:

... a Center Circle shall be marked and have a radius of **7m... A Center Line shall be marked through the center of the field parallel to the goal lines.**

Rule 5 Teams

A. Change:

... A Roster of **15** players constitutes a full team. Any number of up to



eight (8) are permitted on the field at the same time. One of these players on each team **may** be the Goalkeeper.

Rule 10 Duration of play

A. Changes:

The duration of the game shall be **20- to 30-minutes**, with two **10- to 15-minute** periods/halves „**running-clock**“, **except the last minute of each half**.

B. After Halftime, which **should not exceed 5 minutes**, teams will change ends.

C. ... The game starts with a draw **at the beginning of each half**. After a goal is scored the **game starts with a Goalkeeper Free Position after the Umpires whistle is blown to start play**.

D. **All players are free to move after a goal is scored**.

H. **Each team may request one 90 seconds team time out after a dead ball or in possession outside the 15m area**.

Rule 12 Start & restart the Game

A. Changes / Additions:

Each half of the game and overtime period is started with a draw. After a goal is scored the **game is started with a Goalkeeper Free Position after the Umpires whistle is blown to start play**.

B. **At the Draw a maximum of three (3) players from each team may be outside the 10 meter areas during the draw. All other players, including each team's goalkeeper, must be inside the 10 meter area. The Goalie may be in her crease. Players must not enter the center circle until the whistle is blown. During the draw, players positioned inside of the marking area must not leave the marking area until possession has been determined and indicated by the umpire's direction signal and verbal 'possession'. Players inside of the 10 meter area may reach over the line with their crosses to play the ball as long as no part of the player's foot is on or over the line (Rule 19.A.10)**

Rule 18 Restraining Line

Change „Restraining Line“ to Center Line.

A. Change:

A team must not:

(1) have more than **5** attack players below / goal side of the **Center Line** in their offensive / attacking end of the field.

(2) have more than **6** defence players below / goal side of the **Center Line** in their defensive end of the field.

Rule 19 Minor fouls rules & penalties



A. 11. *Change:*

During the Draw and at all other times during the game Goalkeepers must remain below / goal side of the *Center Line*.

The diagram illustrates the layout of a handball court, which is 40m wide and 40m long. Key dimensions and areas are labeled:

- Goal Area (Torkreis):** A semi-circle with a radius of 3m, centered on the goal line. The distance from the center of the goal to the top of the goal area is 10m. - Goal Circle:** A circle with a radius of 7m, centered on the goal line.
- Goal Line:** A line 6m from the top and bottom edges of the court.
- Team Bench Area:** A rectangular area on the right side of the court, 15m long and 2m wide. It is divided into a "Sub Area" (5m long) and a "Scorer Table" area (2m long).
- Other Dimensions:** The distance from the top of the goal area to the top of the court is 43-53m. The distance from the bottom of the goal area to the bottom of the court is 6m. The distance from the center of the goal to the top of the goal area is 10m. The distance from the center of the goal to the bottom of the goal area is 10m. The distance from the center of the goal to the top of the goal area is 4m.
